


Q1 In which state do you perform the majority of your embalmings? (If you prefer not to disclose, select that option from the dropdown menu.)









Q2 Have you observed any large whitish "fibrous" structures/clots in the corpses you have embalmed?









Q5 What percentage of the corpses in the Year 2022 that you have embalmed have had the large whitish "fibrous" structures/clots? (Please select only one answer.)





So the person could have clots throughout their abdomen, arms, legs, head (wherever), and when we push embalming fluid through, we're trying to move those clots to where we can reach them with our forceps to pull them out. We often can't even get our forceps all the way into the vein because of blockages. We have also seen a lot more swelling in arms, legs, genitals, etc. than we used to. Typically that was always do to congestive heart failure. Nowadays I feel as if I am putting in an "edema reducing" fluid into close to 50% of the bodies I'm embalming.
